

How to Restore Updated Graphics Files to The Marina Program

Overview

Restoring graphics files updated by Watch Captain for The Marina Program (TMP) is simply a matter of copying and pasting the new **.btn* and **.hrb* files, and when provided any updated **sdf*, *accounts.dat* and *harbgraf.dat* files to your ccMarina folder. You'll start by backing up your data file, renaming your old **.btn* and **.hrb* files, as well as the *accounts.dat* and/or *harbgraf.dat* files when provided, and then copy your new files into your ccMarina data file folder (the one located on your server if you are running in a network environment).

Back-Up Your TMP Data file

- 1) Make sure everyone is out of The Marina Program.
- 2) Make a backup copy of your ccMarina data folder (the one located on the server for networked environments) and preserve the copy somewhere you can access if we need to go back to it or part of it. You can follow either of these methods for creating the back up:
 - a. You can back up the entire data file, history and all, by copying the entire ccMarina folder to a new location and renaming it.
 - b. Or, you can create a daily backup through The Marina Program and save it to the TMPbackup folder or wherever you normally save your daily backups.

Rename Your Original/Current Graphics Files

This step is recommended for ease of restoring your original graphics should there be a compatibility issue or error with the updated graphics.

Find and rename the files we are going to replace in your working ccMarina folder by adding "replaced20090519" at the end:

- a. Rename ***.btn** to **.btn.replacedYYYYMMDD*
- b. Rename ***.hrb** to **.hrb.replacedYYYYMMDD*
- c. When an **Accounts.dat** file is provided, rename it *Accounts.dat.replacedYYYYMMDD*. This file is provided when you have commissioned Watch Captain to also update your Space Inventory to reflect added spaces.
- d. When **Harbgraf.dat** file is provided, rename it *Harbgraf.dat.replacedYYYYMMDD*. This file is provided when you have commissioned Watch Captain to add new pages to your harbor graphics.

Copy Your Replacement Files into the ccMarina folder

If you have a **stand-alone, single workstation environment**, you will copy the new files we have sent you into the ccMarina folder on your local hard drive.

For **network or multi-workstation installations** of The Marina Program, you have ccMarina folders on the remote workstations and the server. Please note that you only need to copy the new files provided into the shared data ccMarina folder on your server.

1. Copy the attached updated files (**.hrb*, **.btn*, and if provided, **.sdf*, *accounts.dat* and *harbgraf.dat*) into the ccMarina data folder (on the server if running The Marina Program in a network environment).
2. Open The Marina Program.
3. Verify the updated graphics display properly.
4. Edit (or verify) the corresponding Space Inventory data in Lists \ Space Inventory.
